Settlement's public schools partnership program has been changing lives through arts education for 10 years. Launched in 2013, Music Education Pathways connects neighborhood schools throughout Philadelphia with Settlement's top-notch faculty, and provides ensemble training experience in band, orchestra, choir, and drumline.

Over the past decade, Music Education
Pathways has served over 1,200 students across 14 schools. At the heart
of the program are its five core values: "not just the skills that make a great
musician," says Director Evan Cannon, but "also skills that prepare you for
anything life can throw your way. Whether our students want to become
professional musicians, doctors, or entrepreneurs, they will have the
persistence to push through the difficult times, the responsibility to earn
trust, the teamwork to support each other, the creativity to think outside the
box, and the self-evaluation to reflect and be a life-long learner."

Each year, the program culminates in a joint performance with students from all participating schools working together to perform a full concert at Temple University's Performing Arts Center. For many students, the chance to perform for their community is what they look forward to the most. "If you have somebody there for you to make you feel happy for doing what you do, it's like a dream come true," says Malonnie from Grover Cleveland Elementary.

This year's 10th Anniversary Concert will be held on Wednesday, May 24, at 6:30 p.m. We hope to see you there!

## YESTERDAY

Founded in 1908, Blanche Wolf Kohn and Jeanette Selig Frank began Settlement Music School as the music program of the College Settlement in Philadelphia's Southwark section, offering services to newly-arrived immigrants in the community.

The music program grew rapidly from volunteers offering piano lessons for a nickel to a full program of instruction in all musical instruments taught by professionals, including several members of the Philadelphia Orchestra.

By 1914, Settlement was incorporated as an independent community school of the arts. The current Mary Louise Curtis Branch building was built in 1917.

In the 1940s and '50s, Settlement experimented with remote satellite and branch locations, and by 1960 had established the Germantown and Northeast (later the Kardon-Northeast) Branches.

In the 1970s, Settlement undertook an ambitious program of education and therapy in music and dance for children and adults with diverse needs, and in the mid-1980s incorporated the Kardon Institute as a separate, allied institution. Kardon later spun off into an independent organization, and upon the Institute's closing in 2014, Settlement launched its Kardon Center for Arts Therapy.

In the late 1980s, Settlement merged with the Jenkintown Music School to create a fourth branch, which moved to a brand new facility in 2011 to become the Willow Grove Branch, and founded a fifth branch in the Wynnefield neighborhood of West Philadelphia.

In 2002, Settlement extended its services to students in Camden, New Jersey, which evolved into our Camden Partnership Branch.

In 2020, Settlement launched Settlement Music Online, which continues to welcome students from across the country.
