- The Adult Orchestra, gives string, woodwind, and brass players a chance to develop their ensemble skills by working on selected repertoire over an extended period. Led by Martin Knoblauch, the Adult Orchestra meets bi-weekly at the Willow Grove branch on Tuesdays from 10:00 am until 12:30 pm.
- Repertoire is varied with an emphasis on symphonic literature of the classical period. The Adult
 Orchestra regularly reads new repertoire. Members' suggestions for additional works are
 welcomed.
- Martin Knoblauch, conductor In the last fifty years Marty has conducted over five hundred works
 of orchestra, opera, and choral repertoire throughout the Philadelphia area. His musical interests
 extend from Gregorian chant to Wagner. He holds Bachelor's and Master's degrees in Orchestral
 and Opera Conducting from the University of the Arts.
- Enrollment in the orchestra is by section and is open until all spots in a section are filled. Once a section is filled, interested members will be placed on a waitlist and contacted by administration.
 Current members will be given a two-week priority period to enroll and secure their spots before new members are able to enroll.
