Rooted in rigorous research and aligned with early learning standards, KWEST integrates school readiness concepts with engaging music, visual art, and creative movement activities. KWEST has been developed with extensive input from educators across various settings, ensuring it meets diverse classroom needs and integrates effectively into different teaching environments.

KWEST empowers teachers to integrate the arts at their own pace, enhancing their students' learning experiences and fostering their creativity. Each lesson highlights areas of growth supported by research, with key tips to strengthen the teaching approach. Lessons support literacy development and foundational reading skills, incorporating strategies aligned with the Science of Reading and offering practical tips and tools for effective implementation.

> DANCING SNACKTIME

YESTERDAY

Our story started in **1908**, when two young women reached out to the Settlement House located at the corner of 5th Street & Christian, wanting to know how they could help Philadelphia's immigrant families. The answer? Piano lessons for a nickel. Fresh out of Bryn Mawr College, at only 22, **Jeanette Selig Frank** and **Blanche Wolf Kohn** set the stage for over a century of service to the community through unlimited access to creative arts education, changing hundreds of thousands of lives in the process.

Soon, members of the newly formed Philadelphia Orchestra, many of them immigrants themselves, joined Blanche and Jeanette and the instrumental program grew. By 1914, Settlement was officially incorporated as an independent community school of the arts, and in 1917, a generous gift from Mary Louise Curtis Bok built Settlement a permanent home on Queen Street and helped expand its programming even further. By 1924, Settlement's conservatory program division offered pre-professional training that was of sufficient stature to launch the Curtis Institute of Music.

From its origins in South Philadelphia, Settlement expanded to cultivate deep roots in many of the city's unique and diverse neighborhoods, becoming an inextricable thread in the rich tapestry of this city. Throughout the **1940s** and **1950s**, Settlement experimented in remote satellite and branch locations, and by **1960** had established the Germantown and Northeast (later the **Benoliel-Germantown** and **Kardon-Northeast**) branches.

In the **1970s,** Settlement undertook an ambitious program of education and therapy in music and dance for children and adults with diverse needs, and in the **mid-1980s** incorporated the Kardon Institute as a separate, allied institution. The Institute later spun off into an independent organization and, upon its closing in **2014,** Settlement reincorporated it and launched the **Kardon Center for Creative Arts Therapy.**

In the late **1980s**, Settlement merged with the Jenkintown Music School to create a fourth branch, which moved to a purpose-built facility in **2011** to become the **Willow Grove Branch**, and founded a fifth branch in the **Wynnefield** neighborhood of West Philadelphia.

In **2020**, Settlement launched **Settlement Music Online**, which continues to welcome students from across the country and provide even greater accessibility to our high-quality creative arts education.

With the continuing commitment of our students, faculty, families, and friends, we can't wait to see what is in store for **tomorrow!**

Incredible Settlement community

Each of our branches provides weekday and Saturday **individual and group instruction** in all instruments, voice, theory, composition, early childhood music, and dance.

The **Kaleidoscope Preschool Arts Enrichment Program** provides children of low-income families with an innovative education featuring daily instruction in art, music, and dance.

Through the **Advanced Study program**, teens interested in pursuing preprofessional training receive coaching, performance experience, and a substantial scholarship for individual study with a senior faculty member.

Settlement's **Adult Chamber Players** program, for ages 40-99, occurs at three of our branches twice a month, and participants are placed in different chamber ensembles every week to play through a wide range of repertoire.

The **Kardon Center for Arts Therapy** supports those with cognitive, emotional, or mental health impairments, using music, movement, and visual arts to help them with everyday challenges and long-term therapeutic goals.

Settlement runs an extensive variety of programs off-site through 70+ **community partnerships** with schools, day cares, elder care and healthcare facilities, and social service agencies.

Music Education Pathways is our intensive after-school ensembles program that provides band, orchestra, choir, and drumline to historically underserved youth at eight under-resourced Philadelphia public schools.

The **Philadelphia Music Alliance for Youth (PMAY) Artists' Initiative** supports young artists from underrepresented communities on their paths to becoming professional classical musicians.






